

**RESOLUTION 2022-20**

**INITIAL RESOLUTION DISCONTINUING THE FISHER STREET RAILROAD  
CROSSING ON ST. FERIOLE ISLAND, CITY OF PRAIRIE DU CHIEN, CRAWFORD  
COUNTY, WISCONSIN.**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Common Council of the City of Prairie du Chien, Wisconsin:

1. The Common Council hereby declares its intention to exercise its power under Section 66.1003 of the Wisconsin Statutes to discontinue use of the following described real property:

The Fisher Street public railroad crossing on St. Feriole Island in the City of Prairie du Chien, Crawford County, Wisconsin.

2. As the railroad crossing is at the intersection of Water Street and Fisher Street and the railroad tracks are located on the Water Street right-of-way, the crossing is discontinued but the street is not vacated.
3. The physical crossing (pavement) shall be removed and barriers installed as shown on the attached map,
4. That attached to this Initial Resolution and made a part hereof, is a map showing the crossing location as above referenced.
